About Our Migrant Education Program

The Migrant Education Program (MEP) provides extra support to migratory children in their education, as required by federal law. The goal is to help migratory students succeed in school, graduate with a high school diploma (or complete a High School Equivalency Diploma), and develop skills so that they can find good jobs. It also helps schools respond to the needs of these migrant students.

Is my family or child eligible for services?

You and/or your children may be eligible to receive free educational or support services if you have moved to a new state or new school district at any time in the last three years in order to seek work with crops, dairy products, livestock, poultry, plants, trees, or fishing; and, if you and/or your children are younger than 19 years of age.
